Effective June 1, 2021


The Oregon-Pacific Chapter, NECA and local 280, IBEW have identified an issue with Residential Wiring Agreement dated 01-01-20 through 12-31-24, Section 3.15a violates OAR 839-020-0045.

Both parties have agreed to modify 3.15a to the following language:


“When employees are required to report to the shop, the employer shall pay for time spent traveling from the shop to the job, between jobs and from the job to the shop, if required. If an employee travels from home to the job or from the job to home the employee shall not be compensated for that time.”
